KEEPING IN TOUCH COME WHAT MAY

24 May 2020

We organised a Zoom meeting with the members of Coexistences. Around fifteen of them connected and appreciated the initiative. Different proposals of themes for Zoom meetings were made and explored.

11 June 2020

The committee and the host families of the 2018 Roots group met via Zoom: 16 people connected, 10 youngsters and 6 members of the committee and host families. The participants were very pleased. This was a touching and exciting moment. We had the impression that it had been a long time since the youngsters of the 2018 group had not seen each other. The gratitude of the participants was huge and they were unanimous in their strong and happy memory: the youngsters repeated how they felt welcome as in a second family; they felt safe and had the impression that Coexistences made no difference between the Palestinians and the Israeli Jews. The committee noted, after this first successful experience, all the interest of organising a first Zoom meeting with each of the groups before their arrival Switzerland.

Numerous virtual conferences have taken place, organised by the many local NGOs who we know, all very interesting and for which we have relayed the announcements on our Facebook page.







SPEAK OUT AND AFFIRM OURSELVES

Project of annexation in the West Bank

In the face of this project, we felt that it was important the association should not remain silent. Below is the text we published on our site and our Facebook page:

For a resolution of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict fair and viable for all.

- Because we believe in dignity, justice and rights,
- Because silence, indifference, scepticism would be the worst of surrenders,
- We, members of Coexistences, Swiss of all origins and convictions, who actively support
 exchanges between Israeli Jews and Palestinians (in Israel and the occupied territories),
- By receiving in our homes in Switzerland since 2006, in order for them to further their dialogue on an equal footing, away from the conflict, in a neutral, supportive and friendly environment.
- We reaffirm our conviction that the resolution of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict cannot be subject to unilateral decisions. On the contrary, this resolution must be negotiated with and by all those involved, so that their aspirations and security needs be satisfied in a just, viable, exhaustive and durable resolution.

New site and refreshed logo

Since our first announcement at the general assembly, the redesign of Coexistences' site has made good progress and will be online at the end of October. This new site will be available under all media platforms (smartphone, tablet or computer) and the content update can be made without recourse to coding, directly executed by ourselves. Over the last year she became more discreet but glad to hear the news from our association to which she was so attached. From the bottom of our hearts we share the sadness of her family and friends.




NEWS 37/EXTERNAL AND INTERNAL ACTIVITIES
